

Elcona Country Club Monday Golf Outing Policy

1. Golf outings to outside groups must be sponsored by an Elcona Country Club member.
2. Golf outings, which require the closing of the golf course, must be held on Monday's and be approved by the Elcona Board of Directors.
3. Request for outings must be submitted in writing to the Elcona Golf Professional with the requested date, time and estimated number of participants. A final count of participants attending must be guaranteed forty-eight (48) hours prior to the event.
4. An outing fee for the use of the golf course, electric carts will be charged to each participant. Elcona members participating in the outing will be charged the full outing fee.
5. Upon approval by the Elcona Board of Directors, an outing contract in which the terms and conditions of Monday outing will be acknowledged, must be signed and returned to the Golf Professional with a 10 % deposit (maximum of \$1,000, non-refundable) to confirm the outing.
6. Rain dates will not be reserved. Every effort will be made to play golf. The Golf Professional and the Golf Course Superintendent have the sole responsibility to determine if golf play may begin, will be delayed, curtailed or canceled. Regardless of weather delay, the outing is responsible to pay the confirmed number of participants. Food service as ordered, will be carried out, rain or shine.
7. All food service menus must be planned 30 days prior to the event. A confirmed number of guests attending is required 48 hours prior to the event. All rental fees and appropriate clubhouse charges pertaining to the event will

be assessed at the direction of the Clubhouse Manager.

8. All food and beverage products must be purchased from Elcona Country Club. Under no circumstances will food and beverage products be permitted to be brought in by outside parties or vendors.
9. All golf related prizes and awards must be purchased from the Elcona Golf Shop or approved by the Elcona Golf Professional.
10. Participants in the outing must adhere strictly to the Elcona Country Club dress code. No denim or cut offs permitted; Shirts with collars must be worn at all times; Shorts must be Bermuda length; Halter and tank tops are not permitted. Metal spikes are prohibited.
11. The outing is responsible for sign age, hole events, and their set-up, with prior approval of the club. Additional set-up, special events and the like, which are approved by the Club and requested to be set-up and run by the Club, will incur additional charges to the outing.
12. All Monday golf outings must generate a minimum of \$ 7,500 of gross sales.
13. All outings will be priced according to the following rates for green fees and cart fees. The club will charge for the guaranteed number of participants, or the actual number of participants attending, whichever is greater.

14. A additional \$ 3.00 per player charge will be added for Pro Shop, Locker Room and Practice Facility services.
15. The outing shall be held responsible for the charge in rental of additional golf carts, as may be required, at a rate of \$45.00 per cart, minimum lots of 10.

Elcona Country Club Golf Outing Contract

The undersigned agrees that all of the participants shall follow all of the club's rules and regulations set forth by the Board of Directors and enforced by the management staff. The undersigned shall be responsible for any damages caused to the golf course, golf carts and or the club house by any participants at the outing.

This agreement is considered tentative until signed by both the undersigned sponsoring member and organization, returned with the appropriate deposit to Elcona Country Club.
